The event will have an informal get-together on the Friday evening, a main Rally on the Saturday, which will be followed by an evening social gathering and award ceremony, and there will be a social run on the Sunday.

Please arrive AFTER 3pm Friday 24th AND everyone must have left by 12 noon on Monday 27th

Camping is available for the nights of Friday 24th, Saturday 25th, & Sunday 26th. It will cost **£15 per night** for Motorhomes, Vans & Caravans and **£8 per night for a tent**. At the informal reception on Friday evening, visitors and local club members can meet in the Rugby Club bar for a drink, a natter and to enjoy the free food provided. The entrants for the Scottish National must arrive, register and **have their machines in position by 9am** on Saturday. The first machines start the route at 10am. Both short and long routes share the same lunch stop. The informal **dinner and award ceremony will be held on Saturday evening** in The Rugby Club, 6.30pm for 7.00pm start. **You must book and pay for your evening meal at the time of entering the event.** Drinks can be purchased from the bar. It would also be helpful if you can **let us know if you will attend on the Friday evening** although there is no charge for that.

For the Sunday run meet at 9.30am, depart 10am and return in the early afternoon. The bar will be open Sunday evening.

Regulations :-

The Vintage Motor Cycle Club (Central Scottish Section) will hold a Road Run and Concours Competition for motorcycles, combinations, tricycles and three wheeled cycle-cars manufactured up to 31st December 2001, the event to be known as the **51st Scottish National Rally for Classic & Vintage Motorcycles**.

The rally will be based at J J Coupar Recreation Ground, Coupar Angus Road, Blairgowrie, PH10 6TR, Scotland.

The run will take place amid the beautiful scenery of Perthshire and Angus, using rural roads.

On Saturday at registration, route data and starting times will be issued. The first vehicle will depart at 10.00am and at one-minute intervals thereafter. There will be a one-hour halt for lunch and vehicles will return to Blairgowrie from approx 2pm onwards.

On Sunday morning (26th July) there will be a social run open to all entrants, 9.30 for 10.00am departure.

1 Eligibility Entrants must be fully paid up members of V.M.C.C. Ltd*. Participation in the event on the day will only be permitted on production of a **current** V.M.C.C. membership card (although **V.M.C.C. day membership is available to non-members for £5** and payable with entry form or on the day).

***The above are conditions of the event insurance with which we and all entrants must comply.**

2 Awards An award ceremony and evening meal will be held on Saturday 25th at 6.30pm for 7.00pm in Blairgowrie Rugby Club's clubhouse. There is an additional charge for the meal which is payable at time of entry.

3 Entries must reach the Entry Secretary and be made on the attached form (or copy thereof) and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Refreshments will be available at the start/finish and extra lunches are available at **£18.00** per head, (no price reduction for children). **Cheques/Postal Orders should be made payable to "Central Scottish Section V.M.C.C." 4 Concours - Judging will begin at 9am at the assembly area.

If your machine is not in place by this time we cannot guarantee that it will be judged .

5 Road Run Short route approx. 55 miles. Long route approx. 85 miles. Tulip Diagram route cards will be provided.

GPX files, suitable for use with Beeline devices etc, can be requested by email in the two weeks before the event.

6 Drivers and Machines

All drivers and machines must comply with current U.K. legislation and regulations for road use. Check your insurance is valid for this type of event. Anyone using the V.M.C.C. recommended insurer will be covered. (Peter James Insurance)

Event number cards will be provided and it is essential that you display these conspicuously.

7 Breakdown

An assist or rescue service will be available throughout the day. We cannot guarantee to be able to recover combinations or three-wheelers since this is dependant upon wheel track etc. We shall, however, endeavour to rescue all riders/occupants and return them to the rally field in order to pick up their own trailer. Travelling marshals will follow entrants to identify riders experiencing difficulties. If these difficulties can't be resolved after 5-10 minutes, a recovery vehicle can be called. Should a breakdown recovery be requested by a rider during the rally, this will be at that rider's/owner's own risk.

8 Accommodation

Camping and caravan pitches are available at the Rally venue **but booking for this is essential - see the Entry Form!** Perthshire also offers a wide range of overnight and holiday accommodation, see **Visit Scotland** web site www.perthshire.co.uk Whilst the organisers will offer assistance, it is the competitor's responsibility to make their own accommodation arrangements.
